Who knows this better than the engineers in Information Technology industry where ever-changing technical demands keep them always on the toes! But this event speaks about engineers taking a session with the kids about practicing Mathematics—the queen of sciences.*

*It's the season of Mangoes and children are enjoying their holidays. With the aim of keeping kids abreast with Mathematics, PeFSSSED organized the event Maths ke Saath in conjunction with members from UDAAN team—the CSR wing of Geometric. Not to compromise with the fun-filled days of vacation, the session was kept activity oriented with several games in mathematics.*

The event was attended by both balwadi children of PEN (PeFSSSED Education Network) centre and other school going children of Rajiv Gandhi Nagar Area. In total, around 25 students participated in the event.

The session constituted games like "Clap and snap": where children were told that a clap is 'one' and a snap in both hands is 'two'. Then clap and snap in different number and sequence and ask students to tell the full count.

There were geometry related enquiries like how many sides a triangle has or how many faces a brick has. Some tricky questions were discussed like which is greater: 1 kg iron and 1 kg cotton or which is bigger: earth or sun.

After the end of mathematics session children performed a skit depicting the usage of electricity. This impromptu performance by the kids speaks volume of the interest and enthusiasm of the kids. Also some of the children recited poetries. We end this report with some of the snaps.
